## 1800s


 The Industrial Revolution and the prosperity that came with it changed the face of America forever.





















Passenger Pigeon population estimate 3-5 Billion, Extinct by 1914




In 1912 only diamonds were worth more by weight than feathers














• First 2 managers were killed by plumage hunters

#### Wildlife Laws


- Lacey Act, 1900

- Bald and Golden Eagle Protection Act, 1972
- Endangered Species Act, 1973



#### Change in Federal Land Management Priorities

- National Parks
- National Forests
- Bureau of Land Management
- Wildlife Refuges

Goal to protect and preserve public lands and the wildlife that depended on them



#### Unintended Consequences

• New Wildlife Laws & Land use Policies no provisions to allow N.A.s- to harvest birds for religious & ceremonial purposes.

- Made it illegal for Native Americans to harvest feathers for religious & ceremonial use.
- Created Black Market for Feathers.







#### Liberty Wildlife Non-Eagle Feather Repository

- The LWNEFR's mission is two-fold.
- 1. Support Native American culture by providing N.A.s with a source of non-eagle feathers for religious and ceremonial purposes.
- 2. Stop the illegal take of birds from the wild, by providing a legal and no cost source of non-eagle feathers to N.A.s.
