Leashes and Leather Strap/Clips

If you are a member of the Education Group at Liberty you know that safety and consistency are high priorities. The processes and equipment used for securing our Education Ambassadors to gloves, and to leashes, has to remain uniform. Only leashes and glove clips obtained from Liberty Wildlife should be used. This way we are able to monitor the safety and security of the equipment.

<u>Small Bird Leashes</u> - (kestrels, screech owls, burrowing owls, merlin etc)

These are the thin leather leashes with a metal clip on one end that are used to secure small birds of prey.

- Must be purchased from Liberty. Cost is \$10
 - Everyone must keep track of their own small bird leash. We suggest you just keep it attached to the glove, and that you put your name inside your gloves.
 - o Jan Miller has access to the supply and can sell one to you most Tues. Sat.
 - Linda Scott has access and can help you on Sundays

<u>Large Bird Leather/Clips</u> – (hawks, owls, falcons)

These are the leather strips with a lobster claw clip at one end that are attached to the left hand of your large bird gloves.

- No Charge For Initial Set
 - New Ed Volunteer's first pair of gloves free of charge
 - Hand Feed Team Members free of charge if you have separate pair for hand feeding
- No Charge For Replacement of Unusable Leather/Clip
 - Cost is \$10 if you want an additional set for additional pairs of gloves
 - Note: May not be available depending on current supply.
 - If you have a glove in need of a leather/clip set, please put it in the bag in the Ed Trailer/Room marked for that purpose. Please be sure your name is inside your gloves, and if you need to pay for the leather/clip please put gloves and payment together – a grocery bag you can tie shut works well.
